

# Kinnickinnic State Park


Pets must be on a leash no longer than 8 feet and under control at all times. Pets are not allowed in buildings, picnic areas or on the swimming beach. A pet picnic area is located at the valley picnic lot near the sledding hill.



| Trails       | Distance            | Difficulty        |
|--------------|---------------------|-------------------|
| Pink Trail   | 1.6 mi / 2.7 km     | easy              |
| Yellow Trail | 1.3 mi / 2.2 km     | easy              |
| Green Trail  | 1.1 mi / 1.8 km     | easy              |
| Purple Trail | 1.0 mi / 1.6 km     | easy              |
| Brown Trail  | 0.1 mi / 0.2 km     | easy              |
| Orange Trail | 0.5 mi / 0.9 km     | more difficult    |
| Blue Trail   | 0.7 mi / 1.2 km     | more difficult    |
| Red Trails   | 10.5 mi / 16.9 km   | easy to difficult |
| Black Trail  | Paved path to beach | difficult         |

**Winter Trail System Use:**  
**Classic-only ski trails: Yellow, Green, Purple, Orange**  
 Winter use and directional designations apply to the classic ski trails once the trails are snowcovered and groomed. NO hiking, snowshoeing, skate skiing, skijoring or pets are allowed on these trails.

**Multi-use trails: Red, Blue, Brown, Pink, Black**  
 Hiking, snowshoeing, skate or classic skiing, skijoring and pets are allowed on these trails. Fat tire bicycles are allowed on the Red Trail only.
